SCHOLARSHIP 2023-2024

Directorate of Social Welfare is implementing the Scheme namely "Post Matric Scholarship and Scholarship for Top Class Education for students with Disabilities" for the Academic Year 2023-2024.

The students applying for the scholarship should first apply for the scholarship through National Scholarship Portal (www.scholarships.gov.in) on or before 15th December, 2023.

After applying through National Scholarship Portal, the students should take print out of the submitted online application and submit the same to the college on or before 20th December, 2023.

The eligibility criteria is as follows:

- 1) The scholarship is open only to Indian Nationals.
- 2) All the components of scholarships are open to students with benchmark disability i.e 40% or more disability as defined in "Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016" and having a valid certificate of disability issued by the competent authority as prescribed under Rules.
- 3) Not more than two children with disabilities of the same parents will be entitled to receive benefits of the scheme. In case the second child is a twin, the scholarship under the schemes will be admissible to the twin.
- 4) Scholarship for studying in any class will be available for only one year. If a student has to repeat a class, she/he would not get scholarship for that class for a second (or subsequent) year.
- 5) A scholarship holder under this scheme will not avail any other scholarship/ stipend. No scholarship will be paid to the students under this scheme from the date he/she accepts any other scholarship/ stipend.

The following documents are required:

- 1) Copy of proof of age (Birth certificate).
- Copy of Disability certificate.
- 3) Income certificate of the parent for the financial year 2022-2023 not exceeding Rs. 2,50,000/- for Post Matric Scholarship and Rs. 8 lakhs for Top Class Education.
- 4) Copy of Fee receipt.
- 5) Copy of marksheets from std Xth onwards.
- 6) Copy of Aadhar card.
- 7) Copy of bank passbook of student.
