At the outset, the Principal of the college welcomed the members. He informed that college is ranked among the 100 Best Colleges in India by the magazine India Today. The B.CA. program is ranked at 70<sup>th</sup>; B.Sc. at 85<sup>th</sup>; B.A. at 88<sup>th</sup> and B.Com. at 89<sup>th</sup>. The BBA program is ranked at 30<sup>th</sup> in the survey conducted by Times of India. The college received A+ grade in cleanliness ranking under "Swachhatam Mahavidyalaya Sanman" awarded by Goa University. Dr. Umesh Gawas has been awarded a minor research project of Rs. 4.10 lakh by the Directorate of Higher Education. The first floor of a new college building

constructed under RUSA fund is complete. The Department of Commerce and Department of Accountancy have been merged. The college activities are disseminated on social media account handled by the faculty. A two day State level workshop on 'Green Audit' and One day Conference in 'Green Chemistry' were organised. In sports, Inter-Collegiate Marathon Championship conducted by the Goa University was won by the college . In the West Zone Athletics Championship, the college student won Bronze medals in 100mts and 200 mts (Sprint), Silver medals in 800 mts (Athletics), 5th prize in 400 mts (Hurdles) and 4th prize in 10,000 mts(Walk).. One teacher submitted Ph.D. thesis. The college signed two MoUs, one with Skillpbul Business Toys and another with KLE Academy of Higher Education and Research. The Skillpbul Business Toys have agreed to provide training to the students for skill development. The college and KLE Academy of Higher Education and Research will share research and development facilities to promote academic and research initiatives.

He said that programmes should be held on capacity building for the students. He suggested that Goa Biodiversity Board can provide some projects to the students under livelihood support plan.
