

Bella Mascarenhas (F.Y.B.A) I felt good to give to those who needed it.


Subheksha Naik (F.Y.B.A) I like to help people, especially those who are in need.

Prashant Mandrekar (Non-teaching staff) we should share from our earnings or savings by way of 'daan' to those who don't have their own families and are neglected by their families.


