- Essay will be evaluated at college level under the supervision of Head of the Institute or his nominee.

- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.

Total	15


Totally twenty students of different streams are enrolled and fifteen students attended the competition.

- ◆ This first round test will be conducted between 12.30 to 1.00pm.
- ◆ Four top scoring teams will be shortlisted for the final round of the competition.
- ◆ The final competition will commence at 2pm.
- ◆ Decision of the Judges will be final and binding.

### **Rules and Regulations for Essay Competition:**

- ◆ **Topic of the Essay: "Relevance of the Thoughts of Mahatma Gandhi in Today's World."**
- ◆ Essay must be hand written in English language only and it should be legible.
- ◆ Length of essay should be less than 2000 words.
- ◆ Participants should not indicate their identity on the script of essay.
- ◆ Essay will be evaluated at college level under the supervision of Head of the Institute or his nominee.
- ◆ Stationary will be provided by the organisers.
- ◆ Script of essay will not be returned to the participants.
- ◆ Decision of the judges will be final and binding.
