About the college

Dnyanprassarak Mandal's College and Research Centre Assagao, Bardez - Goa, had marked its beginning in the field of Higher Education by establishing V.N.S. Bandekar College of Commerce in the year 1974 to cater to the needs of Commerce Education of the students from across the North Goa. College took the privilege of being the first commerce college on the northern side of river Mandovi. Towards the accomplishment of inclusive education, Dnyanprassarak Mandal had marched ahead and introduced a degree programs in Arts and Science (B.A. and B.Sc.) in the year 1996. Recognizing the need of basic applied skills in industry in Computer and Management, the Management added two more degree specialized degree programs viz. B.C.A. and B.B.A. in the year 2006. Marching ahead towards meeting an increasing need of learners of Higher Education and to provide a vertical mobility to the commerce graduates, the management introduced a post graduate M.Com. program in the year 2006.

College introduced M.Sc. in Pharmaceutical Chemistry in the year 2009 to link Higher education to the needs of Pharmaceutical Industry in Goa. It is unique course where the curriculum is being designed by industry personnel in consultation with faculty to enhance the employability of the students. In order to make the teaching learning process more effective and meaningful, the institution has started Research Centres in Commerce as well as in Chemistry in the year 2012 and 2013 respectively. To further strengthen the post graduate learning, another post graduate M.Sc. program in Organic Chemistry was introduced in the year 2017. During the past 46 years of its journey, the college has made a spectacular growth in the field of higher education to meet emerging needs of Industry and Society. More than 30,000 alumni in diverse field across the globe is a testimony of the dedicated efforts of the college for social transformation and Nation building.

The college was accredited with A grade by NAAC in the third cycle of Accreditation in the year 2015. The institution has been assessed and accredited by NAAC as early as in May 2004 and got B+ grade. The need of preparing perspective plan for the next ten years was felt soon after the second cycle of NAAC accreditation in the year 2010. To have a planned proposal in hand for the better expansion and growth of different educational programs.

Perspective Plan for the college for the next ten years (2020 to 2030) was prepared under the Chairmanship of Prof. M. R. Patil with Mr. Paresh Sirsat, Dr. Rajesh Pednekar, Ms. Smita Kuncolienkar and Mr. Jeevan Khedekar as members of the committee. Draft plan was first placed before the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college. The suggestions made by the IQAC were incorporated into and the same was then forwarded to the management of the college. The management approved the draft with minor modifications. The committee incorporated the modifications suggested by the management and plan was finalized. Detailed overview of the perspective plan of the college for the next ten years is as follows :

I. Infrastructure and Learning Resources

College campus is spread over an area of more than 80,000 sq. mts. There are eight independent different faculty buildings with adequate spaces, four computer laboratories , six science laboratories catering to undergraduate and postgraduate programs. Language and commerce laboratory helps in enhancing the employability of the graduates. Well-equipped automated library with sufficient printed and e- resources helps students and faculty members making teaching- learning very effective.
