FORMATION OF COLLEGE STUDENTS' COUNCIL FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR, 2026-2027

(As per Rule – 04 notified by Goa University – Displayed on the College Notice Boards)

The Principal of Dnyanprassarak Mandal's College and Research Centre hereby notifies the election for the posts of a General Secretary, Sports Secretary, Cultural Secretary, Ladies Representative, Research Students' Representative and Class Representatives for the formation of College Students' Council for the academic year 2026-2027:

Date and hour of election: on 11th August, 2026 between 10.00 a.m to 10.30 a.m.

Rules of eligibility to participate in the election :

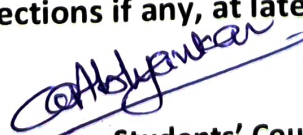
1. Bonafide students whose names figure on the college attendance roll as on 1st working day of August will be eligible to vote on producing valid college identity card/valid library card.
2. Bonafide students who wish to contest the elections should submit the filled in prescribed nomination form (available in the office) on the date and time as notified.
3. Bonafide students must have enrolled for full time course duration of atleast one year.
4. Bonafide students contesting for the post of General Secretary, Sports Secretary, Cultural Secretary, Ladies Representative, Research Students' Representative and Class Representative must have cleared all papers of previous examinations including internal, external and departmental/college examinations of the respective degree and should not be repeater or sought readmission in the same class (attach a copy of marklists of all earlier semesters).
5. Students admitted for one term/few courses in all the terms during the academic year are not eligible to contest the elections.
6. Bonafide students of the college can contest for the post of General Secretary, Sports Secretary, Cultural Secretary, Ladies Representative, Research Students' Representative and Class Representative. Bonafied students can contest for the post of Class Representative for the class in which he/she is studying.
7. Students involved in the cases of indiscipline, unfair means in the examinations, booked for past criminal record, etc. are not eligible to contest the election (Please see Rule-04).
8. Undergraduate student shall have completed 17 years, and shall not be more than 22 years of age, Post graduate students shall not be more than 25 years of age and Research Students' shall not be more than 28 years of age on the date of the scrutiny.

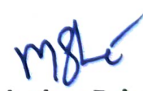


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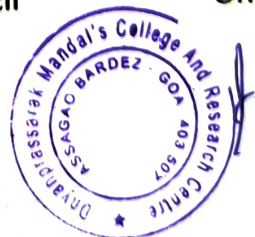
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9. No student shall contest elections to more than one position of the Students' Council.
10. The Candidate to the position of General Secretary of the Students' Council shall be a student who has successfully completed at least one year of his/her respective program of study.
11. No elector can propose or second more than one candidate contesting for the same post.
12. Both the proposer and seconder of the nomination form shall have no backlogs of any of the courses of the earlier examinations including internal, external and departmental/College examinations of the respective degree (Proposer and Secunder should enclose marksheets of all the earlier semesters).
13. An elector cannot either propose or second his/her own candidature. Incase of Class Representative, the proposer and the seconder shall be from the same class as that of contestant.
14. Elections for the posts of General Secretary, Sports Secretary, Cultural Secretary, Class Representative, Research Students' Representative and Ladies Representative shall be held by secret ballot by marking 'X' against the name of the candidate of the elector's choice.
15. Incomplete and unsigned nomination papers and also which do not comply with other eligibility rules stated as above shall be rejected.
16. Election for the post of General Secretary, Sports Secretary, Cultural Secretary, Class Representative, Research Students' Representative and Ladies Representative will be held in the respective Classes, if required.
17. The maximum permitted expenditure per candidate shall be Rs.5,000/-. Each candidate shall, within two weeks of the declaration of the result, submit complete accounts to the College authorities.
18. Candidates or their representatives may remain present at the polling venues to witness the counting process by 10.30 a.m on the day of counting. In case of representative, the concerned candidate should nominate them by writing to the Election Officer on or before 11/08/2026 by 10.00 a.m. Incase they fail to do so, the counting will be taken up as stated at 10.30 a.m. Objections if any, at later stage will not be entertained.

PROCEDURE OF THE ELECTION:

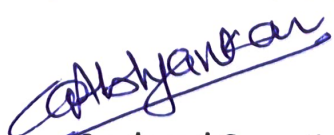
- 1) Election, if required, for the post of the General Secretary, Sports Secretary, Cultural Secretary, Class Representative, Research Students' Representative and Ladies Representative shall be held by secret Ballot.
- 2) Only bonafide students of the college shall be allowed to vote on producing their valid Identify Cards/Library Cards.
- 3) Date, Hour, place and name of the person and its designation for issuing nomination papers.

- 7) Date and timing of election: on 11/08/2026 between 10.00 a.m to 10.30 a.m.
- 8) Counting of votes: on 11/08/2026 at 10.30 a.m. or after the completion of voting process whichever is later in the respective class-rooms.
- 9) Declaration of election results (on college notice board): on 11/08/2026 after the counting of votes is completed.
